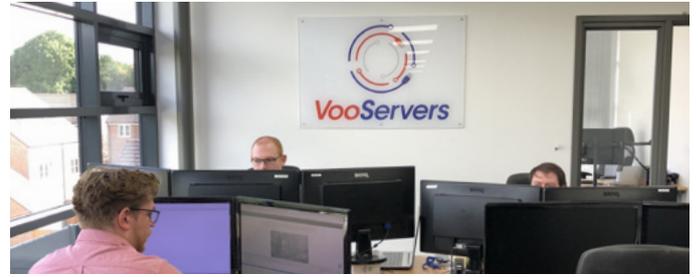

Our Visit To The FAR Academy Trust

Earlier this year, we donated computers and a server to The FAR Academy Trust in Whitstable. CEO of the academic charity, Brent Lewis, recently showed our Technical Director Matt Parkinson and Web and Marketing Strategist, Jordan Bradley-Stopps around the educational learning hub to see how the students are benefiting from the computers.

The FAR Academy Trust is a unique facility that provides an alternative education programme for young people aged 16-24 years old that may otherwise struggle in a regular classroom setup. Through the donation of the computers, the young people are able to complete the vocational and project-based areas of the qualifications more easily. This includes research tasks, printing designs and using CAD software for the laser cutter.

Brent explains how the computers have made a difference to the young people at the academy: *“The support that we have received from VooServers has been invaluable.*
